SUPRA TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION SYSTEMS, INC.'S AGREED EMERGENCY MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Supra Telecommunications and Information, I n c. ("Supra"), pursuant to Rule 28-106.204(5), Florida Administrative Code, requests that the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant the parties a time extension until September 7, 2004, in which to file their Direct Testimony and Exhibits in the instant proceeding. In support of this motion, Supra states the following:

- 1. Pursuant to the Order Establishing Procedure, issued on August 19, 2004,
 Order No. PSC-04-0809-PCO-TP, Direct Testimony and exhibits are due on September 3, 2004.
- 2. Due to the fast approaching Hurricane Frances which is projected to begin to impact the Miami area by as early as Friday (September 3, 2004) morning, hurricane warnings have already been posted for the eastern sea board of Florida from Florida City to Flagler Beach. As a result, Supra has closed its facilities so as to get ready for the impending hurricane. Supra's facilities will remain closed until Tuesday, September 7, 2004. Thus, Supra would need the additional time to file its Direct Testimony and exhibits in the captioned docket.
 - 3. Neither the parties nor Staff would be prejudiced by a time extension in this instance.
- 4. Supra has conferred with both BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.'s counsel and the Commission staff, and all parties are agreeable to an extension of time in this circumstance. This time extension should apply to BellSouth as well.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Supra respectfully requests that the Commission grant the parties a time extension until September 7, 2004 in which to file their Direct Testimony and exhibits.
