

Number 30 is staff's recommendation in Docket Number 030300,

FPTA's petition for review of BellSouth's intrastate payphone tariffs for pay telephone access services.

Mr. Fordham has a brief clarification, and then staff is prepared to answer any questions you might have.

FORDHAM: Commissioners, during the prehearing on this docket there was a unanimous agreement that any findings by the Commission on these issues would apply to all payphone service providers as opposed to only those who were members of the FPTA. All of the language in the recommendation component and the discussion component of this rec are consistent with that agreement; however, we neglected to change the wording of the original issues as they were lifted and put in here. So to make that clarification, in two locations we would like to substitute the term "FPTA members" and instead put "all payphone service providers."

The first location is on Page 11 of the rec, top of the page, Issue 1, the first sentence. Substitute there the term "all payphone service providers" instead of "FPTA members." And the second location is on Page 28 of the rec, Issue 2D, and it's also top of the page, first sentence, same
