3 Florida Public Service Commission Staff.

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P R O C E E D I N G S

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2 COMMISSIONER DEASON: We are now on Item 30. Staff,
3 if you could introduce the item and then we'll proceed.

4 MR. BROWN: Good afternoon, Commissioners. Item
5 Number 30 is staff's recommendation in Docket Number 030300,
6 FPTA's petition for review of BellSouth's intrastate payphone
7 tariffs for pay telephone access services.

8 Mr. Fordham has a brief clarification, and then staff
9 is prepared to answer any questions you might have.

10 MR. FORDHAM: Commissioners, during the prehearing on
11 this docket there was a unanimous agreement that any findings
12 by the Commission on these issues would apply to all payphone
13 service providers as opposed to only those who were members of
14 the FPTA. All of the language in the recommendation component
15 and the discussion component of this rec are consistent with
16 that agreement; however, we neglected to change the wording of
17 the original issues as they were lifted and put in here. So to
18 make that clarification, in two locations we would like to
19 substitute the term "FPTA members" and instead put "all
20 payphone service providers."

21 The first location is on Page 11 of the rec, top of
22 the page, Issue 1, the first sentence. Substitute there the
23 term "all payphone service providers" instead of "FPTA
24 members." And the second location is on Page 28 of the rec,
25 Issue 2D, and it's also top of the page, first sentence, same

1 substitution, instead of "FPTA members," it should read "all
2 payphone service providers."

3 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. That concludes your
4 introduction?

5 MR. BROWN: Yes, it does.

6 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. Commissioners, you want
7 to proceed issue by issue, questions? How do you want to
8 proceed?

9 COMMISSIONER DAVIDSON: I have no questions.

10 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. Commissioner Bradley, do
11 you have any questions?

12 Could I have a motion?

13 COMMISSIONER DAVIDSON: Move staff.

14 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Move staff on all issues?

15 COMMISSIONER DAVIDSON: Yes.

16 COMMISSIONER DEASON: It's been moved. Is there a
17 second?

18 COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Second.

19 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Moved and seconded. All in
20 favor say, "aye."

21 (Simultaneous affirmative vote.)

22 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Show that staff's
23 recommendation is approved on Item 30.
