By letter received June 29, 2004, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed a request for approval of amendment to the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement with Preferred Carrier Services, Inc. d/b/a Telefonos Para Todos and d/b/a Phones For All. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was September 29, 2004.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on October 4, 2004. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.d of the Administrative Procedures Manual.
