<u>Issue 3:</u> What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be

refunded in the January, 2005 through December, 2005 period?

FPU's Position: \$335,737 (overrecovery)

Issue 4: What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap)

factor to be charged during the period January, 2005 through December,

2005?

FPU's Position: 89.181 cents per therm.

<u>Issue 5</u>: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment

charge for billing purposes?

FPU's Position: The factor should be effective for all meter readings on or after

January, 2005, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for

the period January, 2005 through December, 2005.
