Review of a Growth Code Denial by the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar)

for the Weekiwachee exchange (Spring Hill)

On February 3, 2004, BellSouth Telecommunication submitted a code request application to NeuStar for one (1) single 1,000 block of consecutive numbers for a specific customer. Also, on February 3, 2004, NeuStar denied BellSouth's application because it did not meet the utilization criteria required for a new block of numbers.

On October 26, 2004, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision to deny numbering resources in the Weekiwachee – Spring Hill (WWSPFLSHDS0) switch located in the Weekiwachee rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for NeuStar code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:
