Request for Permission from Department of Financial Services to Write-Off the

\$25,000 Penalty Imposed on Inter Con Communications

On November 16, 2004, Docket No. 041314-TI was established to address Inter Con Communications's violation of Sections 364.02 and 364.04, Florida Statutes. Inter Con Communications failed to remit the \$25,000 penalty levied by Order No. PSC-05-0152-PAA-TI, issued on February 8, 2005. The Commission further ordered that if Inter Con Communications failed to pay the \$25,000 penalty within fourteen (14) days after the issuance of the Consummating Order, the company would be required to immediately cease and desist providing intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Florida. The Commission further ordered that the penalty be sent to the Department of Financial Services for collection and, that the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services should request permission to write-off the uncollectible amount.

Therefore, staff requests that the Bureau of Administrative Services/Fiscal Services Section take the appropriate steps to seek permission from the Department of Financial Services to write-off the uncollectible \$25,000 penalty for Inter Con Communications.
