The Commission is currently scheduled to consider the subject outage exclusion request at its May 31, 2005 Agenda Conference. By this letter, Progress Energy respectfully asks that this matter be deferred to a subsequent Agenda Conference. This deferral will provide the Company an opportunity to evaluate the effect on its pending request of several related recent developments, including the comments and concerns discussed at Staff's May 18<sup>th</sup> meeting with the utilities and interested parties regarding the Commission's outage exclusion rule. Progress Energy believes the outcome of its evaluation has the potential to facilitate the orderly and efficient disposition of this proceeding.

Progress Energy understands it is Staff's desire to schedule the Company's pending request in tandem with the outage exclusion request of Tampa Electric Company in Docket No. 050058-EI regarding the same December 26, 2004 outage event. I have therefore discussed Progress Energy's deferral request with counsel for Tampa Electric and have been authorized to represent that his client concurs with the deferral of its pending request as well. It is the intention of Progress Energy and Tampa Electric to use the deferral period in order to meet with the other investor-owned utilities for the purpose of addressing the issues discussed at Staff's May 18<sup>th</sup> meeting.
