On behalf of the South Florida Hospital and Healthcare Association ("SFHHA"), I am requesting that you defer the Commission's consideration of Item 6 (Docket Nos. 050045-EI and 050188-EI) from the Commission's agenda conference from next Tuesday, July 19, until the Commission's agenda conference on Tuesday, August 2. This is the second request for deferral of the Commission's consideration of this item. I am making make this second request because SFHHA is still considering alternatives that may moot its pending petition to conduct a general rate case and associated request for a hearing, which is the subject of your Staff's recommendation in Docket No. 050045-EI.
