By this letter, Cincinnati Bell Public Communications Inc. ("CBPC") seeks to withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide Customer-Owned Coin-Operated Telephone Service in the state of Florida. CBPC's certificate to provide service was awarded by Consummating Order issued May 3, 2001 (Order No. PSC-01-1071-CO-TC, Docket No. 010108-TC). As of December 1, 2004, CBPC sold the entirety of its assets in Florida to HSI Telecom. HSI Telecom assumed responsibility for all payphones formerly operated by CBPC beginning on December 1, 2004.
