On June 16, 2005, the City of Madeira Beach, Florida, submitted a petition, pursuant to Florida Statutes, Section 120.54 (7), for amendment to Public Service Commission Part IV, General Service Provisions 25-6.044 (4). The City's petition was made after receiving complaints from our residents that local utility services had failed to provide adequate notice of scheduled service disruptions within our community. In placing sole reliance upon the complaints of our citizens, the City did not engage local utility service providers in a dialogue about their notice procedures for scheduled disruptions. Having since done so, we are writing to withdraw our request for amendment of the above-referenced rule.

Please accept our apology for any inconvenience or work resulting from our original request. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.
