## To the Commission:

At the suggestion of Richard Wright of the Commission Telecommunication staff I am writing to advise you that Working Assets Long Distance is a switchless reseller. Our company has no facilities of its own, nor do we lease any equipment. Instead we purchase long distance service from Sprint.

The reason for my letter is the requirement in Commission Order No. PSC-03-1469-FOF-TL dated December 24, 2003, for Interexchange carriers to flow through the upcoming reduction of ILEC switched access charges. Since Working Assets does not pay access charges, we will be unable to flow through the reduction that incumbent LECs will be making this fall. However, as directed by the Order, Working Assets will be removing from its Florida tariff the instate connection fee and ceasing to charge it to Florida customers.
