

Issue 2: What is the appropriate conservation cost recovery factor for the period January, 2006 through December 2006?

FPUC's Position:

The appropriate conservation cost recovery factor on a consolidated basis is \$.00047.

Issue 3: What should be the effective date of the conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?


FPUC's Position:

The conservation cost recovery factors should be effective for the period January, 2005 through December, 2005, and to billings thereafter until other conservation cost recovery factors are approved by the Commission.
