After reviewing the application in the above referenced docket, staff has identified the following deficiencies and additional information needed to complete our review and processing of the application.

1. As required by Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the utility must provide notice of the application to the governing bodies of the municipality, county, or counties, and privately owned water

OTH	3.	As evidence of financial ability to provide water and wastewater service to the area, please provide a detailed financial statement, certified if available, of the financial condition of the applicant, that shows all assets and liabilities. A copy of the utility's most recent

balance sheet, income statement, and 2004 federal income tax return should be provided. The financial statements should demonstrate that the applicant has ample capital resources to support the financial needs of the utility. In addition, provide a list of all entities and affiliates, upon which the applicant is relying to provide funding to the utility.

### Additional Information

- 1. We understand that the rates being charged to the customers are the county's residential rates. Please provide a schedule showing the operating expenses incurred by the utility to provide water and wastewater service, using the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners Uniform System of Accounts (NARUC USOA). The utility will need to set up its books using the NARUC accounts in order to provide this schedule. Should you need a copy of the NARUC USOA, we can provide one to you if requested. Please also provide a schedule showing the proposed capital structure of the utility.
- 2. Please provide the monthly gallons of water and wastewater service purchased from the county and the total monthly gallons of water used by customers, as well as the dollar amounts billed to Island Club by the county for these services, from January 2004, to the present.
- 3. Please submit a copy of the bulk service agreement the utility has with the county for the purchase of water and wastewater service.
- 4. Please provide a statement regarding contractual services. The statement should include detailed information as to how the proposed costs are determined for each of the services provided by the contractor and listed in NARUC USOA. If services to operate and manage the utility are currently under contract, please provide a copy of the contract. Also, provide a list that includes names and duties of the utility employees.
- 5. Please provide copies of purchased power (electricity) invoices for lift stations from January 2004, to the present.
- 6. Please provide documentation to show whether the cost for the water and wastewater lines is being depreciated or has been written off to the cost of goods sold on the property owner's tax returns. If the lines are being depreciated, provide a copy of the depreciation schedule from the 2004 tax return.
- 7. Please submit the original and two copies of the water and wastewater tariff containing all rates, classifications, rules and regulations. The tariffs that were previously submitted were not filled out correctly. Please submit water rates in the water tariff and wastewater rates in the wastewater tariff. In addition, please submit a copy of a customer bill, which contains all information required by Rule 25-30.335(1), Florida Administrative Code, on Original Sheet No. 22.0 of the water tariff.
- 8. Please resubmit Original Sheet No. 24.0 with a description of the utility's proposed service availability policy. The policy should describe who is responsible for the

construction of on-site and off-site lines, hydrants, meter installations, and whether the facilities constructed by the developers will be conveyed to the utility. If the development is built out and all lines installed, please describe when those lines were installed, by whom, and the total dollar cost.

- 9. Are there other utilities within the area that might be able to provide service to this territory? Does the applicant own other water and wastewater utility systems or companies?
- 10. Based on your application, there is a club house and pool to which the utility provides water and wastewater service. Are the club house and pool facilities charged for utility service? If so, what are those charges?
- 11. Are there any other facilities other than the residences, club house, and pool to which the utility provides water and/or wastewater service?

The original and four copies of the response to the information requested in this letter should be filed with the Commission on or before **November 11**, 2005. When filing the response, please be sure to refer to the docket number and to direct the response to:
