Dear Mr. Rendell:

Enclosed please find original and six copies of the Eight Revised Tariff Sheet No. 16.1 available to the service of the RV Park.

On October 11, 2005 I inspected the RV Park and noted 84 RV spaces out of a total of 244 being used on a permanent basis. These spaces have either mobiles or modules on them of a permanent nature. They can not be moved like a typical RV and many have structures attached to them. In addition Module Park Homes are being sold and the spaces rented to them.

We calculated the ERC on the RV Park as follows: 84 permanent spaces plus 40% occupancy of the remaining 160 spaces equaling 148. We then applied a 75% factor giving us equivalent ERC's of 111.

Our base facility charge was determined by multiplying our ERC rate of \$11.65 by the 111 equaling \$1,293.15.

Previous to October 1, 2002 the RV Park was being billed according to this tariff. On October 1, 2002 the company signed a new agreement with Lee County for purchase of treated potable water. Since the availability of this tariff was no longer available we began charging the general service rate for a 3" meter on that date.
