



Notes to Financial Forecast

NOTE A -SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This summary of significant accounting policies of Alpha Phone is presented to assist in the understanding of the Company's financial forecast. The financial forecast and notes are representations of the Company's management that is responsible for their integrity and objectivity. These accounting policies conform to generally accepted accounting principles and have been consistently applied in the presentation of the financial forecast.

1) Organization

Alpha Phone was incorporated in 2005 under the laws of Florida with an authorized capitalization of 200 shares of common stock with no par value, all of which were issued and outstanding.

2) Business Activities

The Company is engaged in the resale of local telephone access which is bought from the major local carrier. Customers include residential as well as commercial users.

3) Assumptions

This forecast is based on figures the Company believes it can attain. The target market is residential users and some commercial users. The following assumptions are made:

Income

The first year income is based on obtaining by the end of the first year 6,000 lines. Of these lines 80% would be residential with 20% commercial. Commercial lines are more expensive and more profitable. Additional features are assumed to be requested by 90% of residential customers and 98% of commercial customers. Such features are very profitable.

Growth


Growth is forceasted at 50% a year. The break down between residential and commercial is as follows: second year residential 75% with commercial 25%. The third year residential 70% with commercial 30%. The forth year residential 65% with commercial 35%, The fifth year residential 60% with commercial 40%. No assumptions have been made for price increases which are possible.

Cost of sales

Cost of sales is based on the known rates charged by the major carrier with no assumptions for rate increases.

Operating Expenses

Operating Expenses have been forecasted to be fixed except for advertising at a 25% annual increase, officer wages at 50%, office expense as a percentage of revenue, and billing & collections as a percent of lines.

Notes to Financial Statements

NOTE A -SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This summary of significant accounting policies of Alpha Phone is presented to assist in the understanding of the Company's financial statements. The financial statements and notes are representations of the Company's management that is responsible for their integrity and objectivity. These accounting policies conform to generally accepted accounting principles and have been consistently applied in the presentation of the financial statements.

1) Organization

Alpha Phone was incorporated in June of 2004 under the laws of New York with an authorized capitalization of 200 shares of common stock with no par value, all of which were issued and outstanding.

2) Business Activities

The Company is engaged in the resale of telephone access which is bought from the major local carrier. Customers include residential as well as commercial users.

3) Accounts Receivable

Accounts receivable consist primarily of the Company's steady ongoing customers. Terms are according to industry standards and are usually paid net 30.

4) <u>Fixed Assets</u>

Fixed Assets are stated at cost. Maintenance and repairs are charged to operating expenses, and improvements are capitalized. Depreciation is computed under the straight line method for financial purposes and the modified accelerated cost recovery system for tax reporting purposes.
