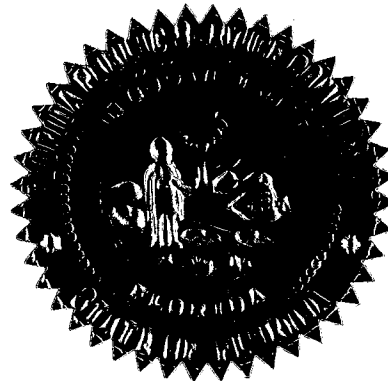

2 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Call the hearing to order.

3 Could I have the notice read, please.

4 MR. SUSAC: Pursuant to notice published October
5 14th, 2005, this time and place have been set for a public
6 service hearing in Docket Number 050693-TL.

7 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Thank you. Take appearances.

8 MR. BECK: My name is Charlie Beck, I'm with the
9 Office of Public Counsel, appearing on behalf of the customers
10 of Alltel Florida.

11 MR. WAHLEN: Jeff Wahlen of the Ausley and McMullen
12 law firm in Tallahassee, appearing on behalf of Alltel Florida,
13 Inc.

14 MR. SUSAC: Jeremy Susac, Commission staff.

15 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Thank you. I'd like to welcome
16 everyone to the hearing this evening. We do have some
17 preliminary matters to go forward with, but let me ask the
18 question. Are there any customers in attendance who wish to
19 either receive information on the proposal pending before the
20 Commission or else here to make a statement to the Commission?
21 If there are, please, could you just raise your hand?

22 Let the record reflect that there are no customers
23 present at this time. We will follow the same process that we
24 did this morning, we'll stand in recess until 6:15 in
25 anticipation that there may be some customers en route. And

1 then at that time we will go through the process of identifying
2 those customers and proceeding.

7 At this time let me repeat the question that I asked

13 present who wish to make a statement to the Commission this
14 evening.

15 Let me ask the parties, are there any matters which
16 need to come before the Commission at this time.

17 Mr. Beck?

18 MR. BECK: None by me, Mr. Chairman.

19 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Mr. Wahlen.

20 MR. WAHLEN: No, sir.

21 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Staff, is there anything we
22 need to address at this point?

23 MR. SUSAC: No, Mr. Chairman.

24 COMMISSIONER DEASON: I think the notice indicates
25 that we will adjourn the hearing at the point at which all

1 customers have been heard. And since it's some 20 minutes
2 after the hour, we anticipate there are no customers planning
3 on attending the hearing, and with that assumption, if there is
4 no objection, we are going to adjourn the hearing.

5 Any objection, Mr. Beck?

6 MR. BECK: No, sir.

7 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. Mr. Wahlen?

8 MR. WAHLEN: No.

9 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Thank you all. This hearing is
10 adjourned.


