On September 20, 2005, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-05-0931-PAA-TI, made final and effective by Consummating Order (CO) No. PSC-05-1007-CO-TI, issued on October 18, 2005, in Docket No. 050268-TI. The PAA Order approved Sprint Communications Company, Limited Partnership d/b/a Sprint's (Sprint's) proposal to issue a refund to affected customers for erroneously billing a monthly recurring long distance plan charge to customers whose long distance services were no longer provided by Sprint Communications Company, Limited Partnership from December 2004 through June 2005. The PAA Order also directed Sprint to submit a report and any amount due to customers who cannot be located to the Commission within 30 days of the issuance of the CO.

Sprint submitted its final report and the monies due to customers who cannot be located to the Commission on November 21, 2005. Staff reviewed the report and determined that Sprint has complied with all of the terms of the PAA Order. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
