The Department has reviewed the application by MSM Utilities, Inc to extend wastewater service for consistency with the Charlotte County Comprehensive Plan. The Department finds that the development is consistent with the Plan.

The proposed development is in an area of the Peace River Shores subdivision bordered on the west by the Peace River, on the north by St. Lilac Street, on the east by US Hwy 17 and to the south by Coco Palm Drive. The Charlotte County Future Land Use Map classification for the area is Low Density Residential. The Low Density Residential land use designation allows up to five dwelling units per acre. The extension of the central wastewater utility will allow property owners to develop parcels to their maximum entitlement and minimize the impact of development on the Peace River. A portion of the southwestern area to be serviced by the utility company is in the Category I Hurricane Evacuation Zone and none of the area is in a flood plain. (See map attachments)




