Dear Ms. Barlow:

The Commission received two checks from the company -- one for \$68 for the 2004 Regulatory Assessment Fee and late payment charges and the other for \$100, which I'm guessing is for a \$100 settlement proposal. However, no letter was enclosed proposing a settlement.

On December 19, 2005, Order No. PSC-05-1237-PAA-TC was issued imposing a \$500 fine. The company has until January 9, 2006 to either pay the \$500 fine in full or propose a settlement. If the company does not send us a letter proposing a settlement, its certificate will be cancelled.
