We are still obtaining prices on the dismantlement and disposal of the water treatment plant but expect the cost to abandon the wells and dismantle and dispose of the piping to not exceed \$10,000. We hope to find someone that will remove the tank free for its salvage value. The newest well pump and motor is more than twelve years old and the well driller has told us that there is very little chance that someone would buy them because of the cost to remove and replace them if there was a failure. The salvage value of the electrical components is less than a couple hundred dollars if of any value. We will be talking to the electrician to see if we should consider using any of the parts in the new lift station.
