Thank you for your correspondence regarding the application filed in the above-referenced docket. In your letter, you indicate that you protest the transfer of Plantation Bay Utility Company (Plantation Bay or utility) shares from Francois Lazare to Morteza Hosseini-Kargar.

Please be advised that the transfer application filed with this Commission indicates that on or about April 9, 2004, Mr. Lazare transferred 775 shares of Plantation Bay stock to Mr. Hosseini-Kargar, who is the President and a director of the utility. Along with the application, Plantation Bay submitted a copy of the Stock Purchase Agreement which shows that the stock transfer did indeed occur. Please also be advised that on February 6, 2006, Plantation Bay filed its Notice of Filing Affidavit of Mailing, evidencing that it sent notice to its customers of the transfer application, which notice included a territory description using section, township, and range references, as required by Rule 25-30.034(4)(c), Florida Administrative Code. Finally, please be advised that this transfer application does not affect the rates that the utility is authorized to charge.

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
