SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, files this Replacement Request for Specified Confidential Classification and states the following.

1. On March 6, 2006, BellSouth filed its First Supplemental Response to MetroPCS California/Florida, Inc.'s, (hereinafter "MetroPCS") First Request for Production of Documents. BellSouth's Supplemental Response to MetroPCS' First Request for Production of Documents, Item No. 3, contains information that is proprietary to BellSouth. BellSouth filed a Request for Specified Confidential Classification on March 6, 2006.
2. Upon review, BellSouth determined that portions of BellSouth's Supplemental Response to First Request for Production of Documents, Item No. 3, were not proprietary. Specifically, BellSouth is withdrawing its previous request with regard to Attachment B.

BellSouth is hereby filing a Replacement Request for Specified Confidential Classification to address Request for Production of Documents, Item No. 3. This request replaces the original request filed on March 6, 2006.

3. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), BellSouth hereby files this Replacement Request for Specified Confidential Classification because Attachment A to Request for Production of Documents, Item No. 3, BellSouth provided in its supplemental response to MetroPCS' First Request for Production of Documents is to be considered confidential and proprietary. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of this information would cause harm to BellSouth and the ICOs. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.24 and Section 364.183, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, *Florida Statutes*.

4. Attachment A to BellSouth's Replacement Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.

5. Attachment B to BellSouth's Replacement Request for Confidential Classification is redacted copies of the document containing the confidential information.

6. Attachment C to BellSouth's Replacement Request for Confidential Classification is a highlighted copy of the document containing the confidential information.

7. The original of this Request was filed today with the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and a copy was served on the Parties.
