The Commission received Elbar Service, Inc.'s 2005 Regulatory Assessment Fee return, however, no payment was included. The return form, dated January 20, 2006, had the handwritten note "Phone disconnected. Not in service." On February 28, 2006, the Commission received a copy of our delinquent notice for the 2005 fee, along with your check for \$60. The delinquent notice stated that the phone line cost more than gross monthly revenues, therefore, you had the service discontinued.

As information, the Regulatory Assessment Fee is owed if a certificate is active during any portion of a calendar year. Since you did not notify the Commission in 2005 that you no longer needed your payphone certificate, Elbar Service, Inc. is also responsible for the 2006 Regulatory Assessment Fee. The 2006 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form is enclosed. Since you have a \$7.00 credit (you only owed \$53 for the 2005 fee and late payment charges), the balance is \$43 for the 2006 fee.

As information, there are two types of cancellation, one is voluntary, which is granted if a company leaves in good standing and does not owe any fees. The other is involuntary, which is when a certificate is cancelled on the Commission's own motion for violation of a rule, order, or statute. If you are requesting cancellation, please write the Commission a letter stating you wish to cancel the certificate, and include the date you stopped providing service. In addition, the company either needs to pay the 2006 fee balance or provide a date certain it will be paid, such as 30 days after the Order granting the cancellation. Please use the enclosed blue envelope, which will insure prompt processing.
