Issue 1: Should the Commission grant BellSouth's Motion to Close Docket?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. In light of the decisions by the FCC and United States District Court, Northern District of Florida, staff recommends the Commission grant BellSouth's Motion to Close Docket and dismiss FCCA's Complaint. The FCC has held that a state commission may not require ILECs to make available Internet service to CLEC voice service customers because it is inconsistent with the Telecommunications Act and FCC regulations. Accordingly, staff believes the Commission cannot grant the relief requested by FCCA in its Complaint.
