

PEF's obligation to contract to purchase firm capacity from such Renewable Providers by means of this schedule and the Renewable or Qualifying Facility Standard Offer Contract will continue only as long as, and the extent that, the subscription limit is not exceeded and, in any event, no later than April 1, 2007 unless extended by the FPSC. PEF's obligation to purchase firm capacity by means of this rate schedule and the Renewable or Qualifying Facility Standard Offer Contract from REPs locating north of the latitude of PEF's Central Florida Substation is conditioned upon PEF being able to acquire import capability to replace that amount of Florida-Southern Interface import capability lost as a result of the location of the Facility.

PEF's obligation to purchase firm capacity by means of this rate schedule and the Renewable <u>or Qualifying Facility</u> Standard Offer Contract from REPs locating north of the latitude of PEF's Central Florida Substation is conditioned upon PEF being able to acquire import capability to replace that amount of Florida-Southern Interface import capability lost as a result of the location of the Facility.
