RE: Docket No. 060295-TL - Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel – Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by North American Numbering Administration for Fort Myers Exchange, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated.

On March 22, 2006, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated (Sprint) requested additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Ft. Myers exchange, South Ft. Myers (FTMYFLXCDS2) switch. Sprint requested these numbers to meet a customer's request, specifically one (1) full NXX code of numbers. On March 22, 2006, Sprint's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for new blocks of numbers.

On March 30, 2006, Sprint filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the Sprint petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
 - 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
 - 3) The customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (April 18, 2006), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide Sprint the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Ft. Myers exchange, South Ft. Myers (FTMYFLXCDS2) switch. Also, please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Catherine Beard at (850) 413-7080.
