Docket No. 060295-TL - Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel – Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by North American Numbering Administration

for Fort Myers Exchange, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated.

On March 22, 2006, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated (Sprint) requested additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Ft. Myers exchange, South Ft. Myers (FTMYFLXCDS2) switch. Sprint requested these numbers to meet a customer's request, specifically one (1) full NXX code of numbers. On March 22, 2006, Sprint's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for new blocks of numbers.

On March 30, 2006, Sprint filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the Sprint petition and has determined the following:

COM	1)	The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
CTR ECR	2)	The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
GCL OPC	3)	The customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.
