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<u>Issue 3</u>: What is the appropriate disposition of Kmart's complaint against FPL?

<u>Recommendation:</u> Kmart's complaint against FPL should be denied on its merits. FPL has complied with the requirements of Rule 25-6.097, Florida Administrative Code. Accordingly, within 30 days of the date of the order, Kmart should pay an additional deposit in the amount of \$299,320 in order to receive continuous service from FPL.
