

BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S THIRD UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSIVE PLEADING

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") hereby files this Third Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Responsive Pleadings to the Complaint of National Telecom & Broadband Services, LLC ("National Telecom") for Breach of Interconnection Agreement and Petition for Emergency Order Restoring Service (hereinafter the "Complaint"), and says:

1. On January 26, 2006, National Telecom filed its Complaint against BellSouth.
2. BellSouth filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File an Answer on February 14, 2006.
3. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-06-0162-PCO-TP, BellSouth was granted an extension until March 20, 2006 to file a response to the Complaint.
4. On March 15, 2006, BellSouth filed a Second Unopposed Extension of Time to File Responsive Pleading asking for an extension of time through and including April 19, 2006.
5. BellSouth now seeks an additional thirty (30) day extension of time, through and including May 19, 2006, in which to file responsive pleadings to the Complaint.

6. The parties have engaged in extensive negotiations and have been able to reach a settlement. However, additional time is required for the parties to formulate and execute a settlement agreement that will resolve the matter in its entirety.

7. BellSouth makes this timely request in good faith and no party will be prejudiced by the granting of this Motion. National Telecom has no objection to the requested relief.


WHEREFORE, BellSouth respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension of time, through and including May 19, 2006, to file responsive pleadings to the Complaint.
