BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S FIFTH UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSIVE PLEADING

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") hereby files this Fifth Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Responsive Pleadings to the Complaint of National Telecom & Broadband Services, LLC ("National Telecom") for Breach of Interconnection Agreement and Petition for Emergency Order Restoring Service (hereinafter the "Complaint"), and says:

- 1. On January 26, 2006, National Telecom filed its Complaint against BellSouth.
- 2. BellSouth filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File an Answer on February 14, 2006.
- 3. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-06-0162-PCO-TP, BellSouth was granted an extension until March 20, 2006 to file a response to the Complaint.
- 4. On March 15, 2006, BellSouth filed a Second Unopposed Extension of Time to File Responsive Pleading asking for an extension of time through and including April 19, 2006.
- 5. On April 19, 2006, BellSouth filed a Third Unopposed Extension of Time to File Responsive Pleading asking for an extension of time through and including May 19, 2006.
