RE: Docket No. 060421-TL - Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel – Petition for expedited review of growth code denials by Number Pooling Administrator for Sanford exchange (Lake Mary), by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.

On May 18, 2006, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Sanford exchange, Lake Mary (LKMRFLHEDS0) switch. BellSouth requested one (1) 1,000 block of numbers to meet a customer's request. On May 18, 2006, BellSouth's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for additional numbering resources.

On May 25, 2006, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the BellSouth petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (June 13, 2006), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Sanford exchange, Lake Mary (LKMRFLHEDS0) switch.
