



#### DOCKET NO. 050317-EI

In May 2005, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC or the company) filed a petition with the Florida Pubic Service Commission (PSC or Commission) requesting the application of a temporary fuel clause additive charge to mitigate the effects of new purchased power contracts that will be effective January 1, 2008. FPUC serves customers in two separate geographic areas; the Northeast or Fernandina Beach division with 15,100 customers and the Northwest or Marianna area with 15,000 customers.

Because FPUC does not generate its own power, it buys power from other utilities. Currently, the cost of these purchased power contracts is substantially below current market prices. These contracts will expire in December 2007. FPUC anticipates that the new contracts which will take effect in January 2008 will reflect market prices at that time.

FPUC seeks to mitigate these higher prices by collecting an additional charge from its customers in 2006 and 2007 and then crediting these amounts back to its customers in 2008, 2009 and 2010. This will smooth out the dramatic increase in electric bills that would otherwise take effect in January 2008.

In both divisions, the initial impact to a residential customer bill of 1,000 kWh per month is expected to be \$2.54, commencing in January 2006. Additional increases of approximately \$2.77 every six months thereafter through 2007 are proposed. These amounts would be returned with interest to FPUC's customers during the 2008-2010 period. In addition, FPUC is proposing at this time to

consolidate its fuel factors for its two electric divisions into a single factor commencing in 2006. If approved, that proposal would have a separate rate impact on each division's fuel charge.

The staff of the PSC has scheduled two customer meetings in the utility's service area to provide customers an opportunity to comment and ask questions regarding the company's proposed fuel surcharge.

PSC staff is scheduled to present an oral recommendation to the Commission at the November 7-9, 2005 hearing. The Commissioners are expected to vote on this matter at that time.

Below is the text of a letter sent to The Attorney General of Florida. The Attorney General recommended that it be fowarded to the PSC as the appropriate agency to receive such comments. As laughable as that is those comments are as follows.

As a rate-paying customer, the Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners is concerned by the enormous fiscal impact of the proposed fuel and purchased power rate increase by TECO (Docket # 050001).

TECO's proposed fuel and purchased power rate increase of 13.7% will translate into at least \$2 million in additional electric costs to Hillsborough County Government. It is our understanding that these new rates are being proposed in response to the increased market costs of fuel, and do not apply to TECO's base rate for electric service. I oppose the proposed electrical surcharge by the Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC). FPUC has applied to the Florida Public Service Commission to begin adding a surcharge to its customer's bills, in anticipation of future expected electric costs in 2008. As stated in October 19, 2005 edition of the Fernandina Beach Newsleader, there is no precedent for this surcharge.

This appears to be an effort to increase FPUC's cash flow and build a huge cash reserve. Mr. George Bachman of FPUC is quoted as saying "The company will not profit". While technically, this may not show up in FPU's profit, it will be a cash asset on their balance sheet that will benefit the company.

Mr. Bachman is further quoted as saying, "I really think a lot of customers will be indifferent." I disagree with Mr. Bachman's assessment. I believe that most consumers shop for best buys on everything from mortgage rates to gasoline to fill up their cars. A reason for possible indifference on electric rates is the futile feeling of opposing the monopoly power of the local utility company. We are dependent upon you, the Florida Public Service Commission to adequately represent our interests against this monopoly power.

FPUC's financial strategy appears to be, "Pay me today, because my costs are going up tomorrow". This application for a rate increase only benefits FPUC. Paying a higher monthly electric rate now, to avoid future "sticker shock" is not in the best interests of local FPUC customers.



## Fuel Adjustments Set For Electric Utilities

**TALLAHASSEE** — Annual fuel adjustment charges approved by the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) and their impact on residential customers of investorowned utilities are listed below.

These adjustments reflect fluctuations in the price paid by utilities for fuel and will become effective during the January 2006 billing cycle. The Commission allows utilities to recover fuel-related costs that are prudently incurred. The following monthly amounts are based on 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of use have been verified by PSC staff:

- Residential customers of Florida Power & Light Company will pay \$108.61 for 1,000 kWh of electricity. This reflects an increase of \$16.99 when compared with the current amount of \$91.62.
- A residential customer of Progress Energy Florida will pay \$109.56 for 1,000 kWh of electricity, which is \$11.78 more than the current level of \$97.78.
- Residential customers of Tampa Electric Company will pay \$109.60 for 1,000 kWh of electricity. This reflects a increase of \$11.53 when compared with the current amount of \$98.07.
- A residential customer of Gulf Power Company will pay \$92.48 for 1,000 kWh of electricity, which is \$4.57 more than the current level of \$87.91.
- Calculations for Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) are not available at this time and will be verified Thursday.

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
