RE: Docket No. 060473-TL - Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Petition for Expedited Review of Growth Code Denials by the Number Pooling Administrator for the Jacksonville exchange (San Marco - 2)

On June 7, 2006, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Jacksonville exchange, San Marco (JCVLFLSMDS0) switch. BellSouth requested four (4) 1,000 blocks of numbers to meet a customer's request. The customer requests codes in the format of NPA NXX2, 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7. On June 7, 2006, BellSouth's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for additional numbering resources.

On June 19, 2006, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the BellSouth petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (July 11, 2006), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Jacksonville exchange, San Marco (JCVLFLSMDS0) switch. Also, please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Catherine Beard at (850) 413-7080.
