Along with that press is information that Lindrick failed to notify customers, et al, in a timely manner, as required by the Florida DEP. I myself tried to contact them shortly after the first newspaper article March 15 and had a very hard time reaching anyone who would acknowledge the issue (the phone went to an answering service even after "business hours" began). I was told that they were in meetings, were at lunch, had left for the day, etc. Four or five phone calls later, together with a message that my next call was going to be to the PSC, finally brought a response, four hours after that.
