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

**PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FLORIDA  
PUBLIC UTILITIES' FUEL ADJUSTMENT AND  
PURCHASED POWER COST RECOVERY FACTOR**

Florida Public Utilities Company ("the Company" or "FPUC"), through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to the requirements of this docket, hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the Company's fuel adjustment and purchased power cost recovery factors for the period January, 2007 through December, 2007. In support hereof, the Company states:

- 3) Pursuant to the requirements of this Docket, the Company has prefiled the fuel adjustment and purchased power cost recovery forms wherein the Company has calculated the appropriate fuel adjustment factor to be approved for the Company for its Northwest (Marianna) and Northeast (Fernandina Beach) divisions.

4) Accompanying this Petition are schedules and testimony reflecting and supporting factors for each division. The final remaining fuel and purchased power adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2005 through December 2005 is an underrecovery of \$53,882 for the Marianna Division and an underrecovery of \$153,867 for the Fernandina Beach Division.

5) The testimony and exhibits also demonstrate that based upon actual data for January 2006 through June 2006 and projected data for July 2006 through December 2006, the estimated fuel and purchased power adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2006 through December 2006 are an underrecovery of \$262,709 for the Marianna Division and an underrecovery of \$738,815 for the Fernandina Beach Division.

6) The total true-up amount to be collected/refunded for the period January 2007 through December 2007 are \$316,591 for the Marianna Division and \$892,682 for the Fernandina Beach Division. The appropriate levelized fuel adjustment and purchased power cost recovery factors for the period January 2007 through December 2007, adjusted for line loss multipliers and including taxes are as follows:

6) As described in the accompanying testimony, the Company has completed an RFP process to select providers of purchased power for both divisions when the current contracts expire. The new fuel contract for the Northeast Division, which the Company has thoroughly analyzed, has an effective date of January 1, 2007, thus the projections which have been submitted incorporate the fuel costs associated with that contract.

10) The fuel adjustment factors, represent properly calculated factors comprised of appropriate components and should be approved.

WHEREFORE, Florida Public Utilities petitions the Commission to approve consolidated and fuel adjustment and purchased power cost recovery factors with surcharge as proposed.
