Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006 of the Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby files its Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification of certain information contained in FPL's projected fuel cost recovery filing in Docket No. 060001-I.

Schedule E12, which is page 7 of exhibit KMD-6 attached to the prepared testimony of FPL witness K.M. Dubin, and Exhibits GJY-3, GJY-4, GJY-6, and GJY-7 attached to the prepared testimony of G.
