FOR JANUARY 2005 THROUGH DECEMBER 2005;
ESTIMATED CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY TRUE-UP AMOUNTS
FOR JANUARY 2006 THROUGH DECEMBER 2006;
PROJECTED CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY AMOUNTS
FOR JANUARY 2007 THROUGH DECEMBER 2007;
AND THE CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY FACTORS TO BE APPLIED

GULF POWER COMPANY ("Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the Company"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Section 366.82(5) of the Florida Statutes and Rule 25-17.015 of the Florida Administrative Code, hereby petitions the Florida Public Service Commission for recovery of the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for January 2005 through December 2005; for approval of its estimated energy conservation true-up amount for the period January 2006 through December 2006; for approval of the projected energy conservation amounts for the period January 2007 through December 2007; and for approval of

the proposed energy conservation cost recovery factors to be applied beginning with the period January 2007 through December 2007. In support thereof the Company would respectfully show:

1. Gulf is a corporation with its headquarters located at 500 Bayfront Parkway, Pensacola, Florida 32520. The Company is an investor-owned electric utility operating under the jurisdiction of this Commission.

2. Pursuant to Section 366.82 of the Florida Statutes, Gulf's energy conservation programs and goals have been approved and adopted by order of this Commission. The implementation of these programs has resulted in certain reasonable and prudent un-reimbursed costs incurred or to be incurred which the Company hereby petitions to be recovered through its rates and charges pursuant to Rule 25-17.015, F.A.C., and the orders and procedures of this Commission.

3. Incorporated by reference into this petition are the testimony and exhibit of William D. Eggart, submitted in May 2006 and the testimony and exhibit of William D. Eggart submitted with this petition.¹ The two composite exhibits present reports of Gulf's various programs and incorporate the appropriate and necessary data and information to show the energy conservation cost calculations projected for the period January 2007 through December 2007 and the appropriate true-up adjustment to be applied based on actual data through July 2006 and estimated data for the remainder of the period through December 2006.

¹The composite exhibit attached to the May testimony contains the Company's CT schedules for the twelve month period ending December 2005. The composite exhibit attached to this testimony contains the Company's C schedules for the twelve month period ending December 2007 and includes data related to the current period January through July 2006 actual and August through December 2006 estimated.

4. The "final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts" were filed with the Commission in May 2006 as shown on Schedule CT-1. The final true-up amount for the period January 2005 through December 2005, as presented in the testimony and exhibit of William D. Eggart filed in May 2006, is \$376,996 over recovery which amount is hereby submitted for approval by the Commission to be included in the calculation of the conservation cost recovery factors to be refunded in the next period.

5. Gulf has calculated its estimated true-up amount for the period ending December 2006 to be an over recovery of \$149,024. This amount is hereby submitted for approval by the Commission to be included in the calculation of the conservation cost recovery factors to be refunded during the projection period.

6. Gulf projects recoverable expenditures of \$10,206,567 for its approved conservation programs during the twelve month period beginning January 2007 and ending December 2007.

7. Gulf projects its retail energy sales during the period January 2007 through December 2007 will be 11,532,472,000 kilowatthours (kWh).


8. On the basis of the final true-up for the period January 2005 through December 2005, the estimated true-up for the period January 2006 through December 2006, the cost projections for the period January 2007 through December 2007, and proper consideration of both projected kilowatt-hour sales and the adjustment for revenue taxes, the Company's proposed conservation cost recovery factors by customer class for the period January 2007 through December 2007 are as follows:

RS, RSVP	0.088
GS	0.087
GSD, GSDT, GSTOU	0.083
LP, LPT	0.079
PX, PXT, RTP, SBS	0.074
OSI, OSII	0.070

WHEREFORE, Gulf Power Company respectfully requests the Commission to authorize the Company to recover its un-reimbursed costs reasonably and prudently incurred in accordance with this petition and thereby approve the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2005 through December 2005, the estimated conservation cost recovery true-up amount for January 2006 through December 2006, the projected conservation cost recovery

amounts for January 2007 through December 2007, and the conservation cost recovery factors to be applied beginning with the period January 2007 through December 2007.

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
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
