BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. Pursuant to Order No. 06-0783-PCO-TL, BellSouth is obligated to provide a copy of discovery responses served on other parties to Commission Staff.
- 2. On September 11, 2006, Florida's Citizens (Citizens or OPC) served its First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-4) and First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-10) upon BellSouth.
- 3. On October 5, 2006 BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed its Response and Objections to Citizens' First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-4) and First Request for Production of Documents (Nos.1-10).
