BELLSOUTH'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") asks the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an extension of time in which to file its response to the Petition to Implement Automatic Enrollment for Lifeline Telephone Service ("Petition") filed by the Citizens of Florida, through Harold McLean, Public Counsel, and AARP (jointly referred to as "Joint Petitioners"). In support of this Motion, BellSouth states the following:

- 1. On or about October 11, 2006, the Joint Petitioners filed their Petition requesting that the Commission order local exchange telecommunications companies in Florida to implement practices and procedures with the Department of Children and Families to automatically enroll eligible customers in the Lifeline telephone program.
- 2. In accordance with Commission Rules, BellSouth's response to the Petition is due on October 31, 2006.
