Dear Mr. Devlin:

On behalf of the above-listed entities (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Aqua Utilities"), and pursuant to Rule 25-30.430(3), Florida Administrative Code, Aqua Utilities hereby requests approval of an extension of time through Friday, December 1, 2006, to file its petition, Minimum Filing Requirements ("MFRs"), prefiled direct testimony, and filing fee associated with its anticipated application for increase in water and wastewater rates.

Aqua Utilities previously requested and was granted approval of an extension of time to file its petition, MFRs, testimony and filing fees by Monday, November 13, 2006. Aqua Utilities is requesting the additional time to ensure, to the maximum extent possible, that its rate request filing is complete and meets the numerous Commission rules and statutes related to rate increase requests, and to allow adequate time for reproduction of the MFRs and testimony. If approved, the extension will not cause the approved projected test year ended December 31, 2007 to be unrepresentative of the current operations of the systems located among the 15 counties. The approved projected test year will remain a representative period to measure cost of service for the purpose of establishing new, prospective rates.


