COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Since there are no customers,

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why don't we, you know, go on a break for about half an hour, wait a little more, and we'll go off the record for a few minutes and come back in half an hour and see what happens.

Is that okay, Commissioners? Thank you. So we're off the record for a half an hour. Thank you.
