Staff needs the following information to assist in its review of UIF's application. Please provide the following information by county.

1. Please provide information regarding the number of bills rendered, the number of gallons sold and the amount of revenues billed. This information should be provided, by customer class, meter size and usage block, for each individual water system in Marion, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas or Seminole County that was included in the most recent Utilities, Inc. of Florida rate case (Docket No. 020071-WS). This information should be provided, by month, beginning the first billing period after the increased rates in Docket No. 020071-WS went into effect. The information should be provided in the format shown below. (Please note that for water systems that did not have an inclining-block rate structure approved in Docket No. 020071-WS, all residential gallons should be classified as B1 gallons.)

  - (c) How much of the incremental difference between the March 2006 and April 2006 13-month average cost rates for long-term debt for Utilities, Inc. and subsidiary companies is due to debt being refinanced as a result of the acquisition of Utilities, Inc. by Hydro Star? Please provide any documentation supporting the Company's response.
- 3. The following items relate to the pro forma plant additions reflected in adjustment (C) on MFR Schedule A-3. For each addition, please provide the following:
  - (a) a statement why each addition is necessary;
  - (b) a copy of all invoices and other support documentation if the plant addition has been completed;
  - (c) a copy of the signed contract or any bids, if the plant addition has not been completed;
  - (d) the status of the engineering and permitting efforts, if the plant addition has not been through the bidding processing;
  - (e) the current status of each plant addition (percent completed, costs to date, and remaining costs);
  - (f) the projected in-service date for each outstanding plant addition;
  - (g) a hard copy of all workpapers showing the utility's calculation of Allowance for Funds Used During Construction (AFUDC) for each project; and an electronic disk containing any spreadsheet file(s) for the utility's AFUDC calculations for each project.
- 4. Will any of the pro forma plant be contributed (CIAC)? If so, please identify the amount and account and where it was reflected in the MFRs as CIAC.
- 5. Is any of the pro forma plant required by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection? If so, please provide documentation showing this mandate.
