Dear Mr. Ross:

On January 26, 2007, BellSouth issued Carrier Notification SN91087013 posting changes to BellSouth's wire center lists that had previously been the subject of various "Change of Law" proceedings (in Florida, Docket No. 041269-TP) implementing the *Triennial Review Order (TRO)* and *Triennial Review Remand Order (TRRO)*. Revisions to the wire center lists were necessitated by the FCC's decision approving the merger between AT&T and BellSouth and requiring, among other conditions, that collocation arrangements established by AT&T or its affiliates not be counted when applying the *TRRO*'s non-impairment rules.

Based on CompSouth's analysis of the data BellSouth provided in the Florida Change of Law proceeding, it is our understanding that wire center MNDRFLLO should move from Transport Tier 2 to Transport Tier 3 with the elimination of AT&T/SBC collocations. This change is not reflected in Carrier Notification SN91087013. Please issue a revised wire center list correctly listing MNDRFLLO as a Tier 3 wire center within the next five days, or provide a detailed explanation as to why it should remain Tier 2.

CompSouth had offered to work cooperatively with BellSouth to revise its wire center lists, continuing the process used during the Change of Law proceeding to minimize Commission involvement.¹ Unfortunately, AT&T/BellSouth declined to work with CompSouth to develop an


