Dear Mr. Ross:

This letter is a follow-up to our letter of January 31st, regarding changes to BellSouth's wire center lists and the status of wire center MNDRFLLO. Although MNDRFLLO is listed as an impaired wire center in Order No. PSC-06-0172-FOF-TP (Docket No. 041269-TP), BellSouth subsequently removed the impairment designation for MNDRFLLO through a letter to the PSC because its claim of non-impairment had been based on an incorrect "validation" provided by an alleged fiber-based collocater. Because BellSouth had already removed the non-impairment designation for MNDRFLLO through this correction, there was no effect on its status as a result of the FCC's merger conditions

We regret any confusion our January 31st letter may have caused. As I discussed with Jim Meza this morning, we had actually discovered the error ourselves and were preparing this response when he and I talked. As you know, CompSouth requested that the cooperative process we used during the state proceedings implementing the TRRO (including the process used in Docket No. 041269-TP) also be used to develop agreed upon changes to wire center lists required by the FCC's approval of the AT&T-BellSouth merger. It was our mutual experience that a cooperative process eliminates misunderstandings. We appreciate BellSouth's efforts to develop a final list of wire centers; however, given the cooperative efforts the parties engaged in during the TRRO process, we are disappointed that we have not been able to discuss the steps AT&T-BellSouth took in reviewing the wire center list so that we could be comfortable that the


