By letter received November 13, 2006, Embarg Florida, Inc. filed a request for approval of Amendment No. 1 to the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement between Embarq Florida, Inc. and Granite Telecommunications, LLC. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved.
