This status report is submitted pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-05-0965-PAA-EU, issued in Docket No. 040133-EU, which approved the currently effective territorial agreement between WREC and Progress Energy Florida.

WREC/PEF Customer Transfer Updates:

(Phase 1: Transfers Complete-March 1, 2006)

Under "Phase 1" of the customer transfers delineated in the currently effective territorial agreement between WREC and PEF, the following customer transfers have been completed:

- Majestic Oaks Development- Hernando County: Under the current territorial
 agreement, the entire Majestic Oaks Development in Hernando County, including
 452 lots previously served by PEF, was transferred to WREC. This transfer has
