On October 9, 2006, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-06-0837-PAA-TI, amended by Amendatory Order No. PSC-06-0837A-PAA-TI on October 12, 2006, and made final and effective by Consummating Order (CO) No. PSC-06-0837A-PAA-TI, issued on November 6, 2006, in Docket No. 060578-TI. The PAA Order approved Bell Atlantic Communications, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Long Distance's (Verizon's) proposal to issue a refund to affected customers for overbilling on certain calling card calls from September 2004 through August 2006. The PAA Order also directed Verizon to submit a report and any amount due to customers who cannot be located to the Commission by February 12, 2007.

Verizon submitted its final report on February 12, 2007. The report stated there were no unclaimed refunds. Staff reviewed the report and determined that Verizon has complied with the terms of the PAA Order. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
