PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FUEL COST RECOVERY AND CAPACITY COST RECOVERY NET TRUE-UPS FOR THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 2006

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby petitions this Commission for approval of FPL's Net Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Recovery ("FCR") true-up amount of \$53,744,558 under-recovery, and Net Capacity Cost Recovery ("CCR") true-up amount of \$4,030,283 under-recovery, both for the period ending December 2006. In support of this Petition, FPL states as follows:

- 1. The \$53,744,558 net FCR true-up under-recovery for the period January 2006 through December 2006 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule 1, page 2 of 2, attached to Order No. 10093, dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibits of FPL witness K.M. Dubin, which are being filed together with the Petition and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. By Order No. PSC-06-1057-FOF-EI, the Commission approved FCR Factors for the period commencing January 2007. These factors reflected an estimated/actual true-up over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2006 through December 2006 of \$216,430,642, which was also approved in Order No. PSC-06-1057-FOF-EI. The actual over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2006 through December 2006 is \$162,686,084. The \$162,686,084 actual over-recovery, less the estimated/actual over-recovery.

of \$216,430,642 which is currently reflected in charges for the period beginning January 2007, results in a net FCR true-up under-recovery of \$53,744,558 that is to be included in the calculation of the FCR Factors for the period beginning January 2008.

- 3. As shown on the year-to-date December 2006 Schedule A6 that was filed with the Commission on January 23, 2007, FPL's 2006 gain on off-system sales was \$19,438,254. This exceeds by \$302,226 the \$19,136,028 benchmark approved by the Commission in Order No. PSC-06-1057-FOF-EI. Consistent with Commission Order No. PSC-00-1744-PAA-EI, issued in Docket No. 991779-EI on September 26, 2000, this \$302,226 exceedance of the benchmark is to be shared, such that 80% (\$241,781) goes to customers and 20% (\$60,445) goes to FPL shareholders. FPL is requesting that the Commission approve \$60,445 as its Shareholder Incentive for 2006, which amount is reflected in the calculation of the net FCR true-up described in Paragraph 2.
- 4. The \$4,030,283 net CCR true-up under-recovery for the period January 2006 through December 2006 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Order No. 25773, dated February 24, 1992. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibits of FPL witness K.M. Dubin.
- 5. By Order No. PSC-06-1057-FOF-EI, the Commission approved CCR Factors for the period commencing January 2007. These factors reflected an estimated/actual true-up under-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2006 through December 2006 of \$18,215,446, which was also approved in Order No. PSC-06-1057-FOF-EI. The actual under-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2006 through December 2006 is \$22,245,729. The \$22,245,729 actual under-recovery, less the estimated/actual under-recovery of \$18,215,446 which is currently reflected in charges for the period beginning January 2007, results in a net

CCR true-up under-recovery of \$4,030,283 that is to be included in the calculation of the CCR

Factors for the period beginning January 2008.

WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests the Commission

to approve FPL's net FCR true-up amount of \$53,744,558 under-recovery and authorize the

inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the FCR Factors for the period beginning January

2008; to approve \$60,445 as FPL's FCR Shareholder Incentive for 2006, which amount is

reflected in the calculation of the net FCR true-up; and to approve FPL's net CCR true-up

amount of \$4,030,283 under-recovery for the period ending December 2006 and authorize the

inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the CCR Factors for the period beginning January

2008.
