

## JOINT PETITION OF AT&T FLORIDA AND WINDSTREAM FLORIDA, INC. (formerly known as Alltel Florida, Inc.) TO TRANSFER TERRITORIES IN ALACHUA <u>COUNTY AND TO AMEND CERTIFICATES</u>

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") and Windstream Florida, Inc. (formerly known as Alltel Florida, Inc.) ("Windstream") pursuant to Rules 25-4.005 and 28.106.201, Florida Administrative Code, jointly petition the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission" or "FPSC") to modify certain exchange boundaries in Alachua County and to amend the companies' certificates accordingly. In support of this petition, Bellsouth and Windstream state as follows:

1. AT&T Florida is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. AT&T Florida provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 8.

2. Windstream is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. Windstream

6. By this petition, AT&T Florida and Windstream seek to amend the Alachua

exchange boundary to transfer the territory associated with four (4) local exchange

customers (single family homes) currently located in the AT&T Florida Gainesville Exchange to the Windstream Alachua Exchange. The territory to be transferred consists of a small pocket of territory east of I-75 that has historically been served by AT&T Florida via an overhead cable that crosses the interstate. Windstream can serve the customers without crossing the interstate in a manner that is both safe and costeffective. A copy of a map showing the area to be transferred is attached as Exhibit "A." A legal description of Windstream's Alachua Exchange showing the proposed boundary changes in legislative format is attached hereto as Exhibit "B."

7. The present exchange and territory boundary was drawn many years ago based on section lines. The boundary change will better align the companies' exchange service areas, and will adjust the boundary to reflect I-75 as a readily discernible terrain feature.

8. As indicated in the letters attached hereto as Exhibit "C," the customers currently in AT&T Florida's territory to be served by Windstream post-approval have requested the transfer. The customers will take service under Windstream's existing tariffs and do not object to doing so. Future customers in the area to be transferred, if any, will also take service subject to Windstream's tariffs. The affected customers will be served by Windstream at prices and calling scopes as set forth in Windstream's General Subscriber Service Tariff. The affected customers are aware of the changes in calling scopes and rates and have not objected.

There are no pending applications for basic local service held by AT&T
Florida or Windstream related to the territory to be transferred.

10. AT&T Florida does not currently hold any deposits or deposit interest for the customers in the area to be transferred.

11. Upon the Commission's approval of the modifications proposed herein, the parties will file the final tariff sheets for administrative approval.

12. No financial exchange or consideration was, or shall be, given for this proposed transfer of Certificated Areas. This Joint Application is the only written agreement between the applicants.

13. Both AT&T Florida and Windstream have agreed that the requested transfer of service area is feasible from an economic standpoint and beneficial to the subscribers of both companies.

14. Pursuant to FPSC Rule 25-4.005, the required affidavits are attached to this Joint Petition as Exhibit "D", and certify that notice of intention to file the Petition has been given to those parties set forth in the above cited rule.

WHEREFORE, Windstream and AT&T Florida request that this Joint Petition be considered, and that the FPSC redefine the boundaries of the Petitioners' Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity as requested in the Petition, and that the FPSC enter an appropriate order to effect such a redefinition.




